## Golf

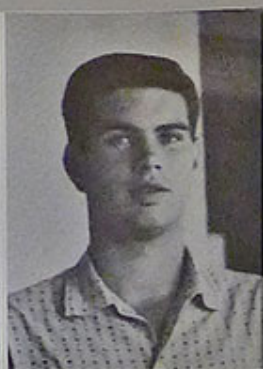
