A "BRAND NEW" VARSITY GOLF TEAM represented Stanford on the fairways this year. Coach Eddie Twiggs, losing all his last year's National Collegiate Championship team, had to build a new squad. With Warren Berl and Don Haslett as the nuclei for the '39 edition, Coach Twiggs saw his divotmen take first place in the four-way Pacific Coast Championship, southern division. Berl and Haslett placed one, two in the meet, held on the Stanford course. A week later the Card golfers lost to California, 17-10, on the Berkeley course. The second match against Cal resulted in a Card 2-1 victory. Don Kennedy, Jack Showalter, Dick Wright, and Bud Finger formed the competing varsity team. As in track, Stanford golf usually gains further fame during the summer months, and thus it remains to be seen what Farm golfers can accomplish.
