

Nov 30, 2012 email from Sandy Adelman '69 to Head Coach Conrad Ray:

“Sorry about the delayed response. I must correct a misperception. I did not win the 1969 conference championship - I came up one inch short on a 100 yard shot from the 18th fairway in an attempt to tie the leaders. Interestingly my teammate Greg Pitzer had come out to caddy for me and urged me to hit a "Worsham" -this refers to Lou Worsham who holed a wedge shot on the last hole to win the 1953 George May championship in possibly golf's first televised tournament.”

“The announcer, Jimmy Demaret, was dumbfounded! In reference to the 1968 conference tournament, Rich Harris finished second 4 shots behind and freshman Tom Watson was third. I hope this helps. I will be visiting the SF area next week, and Rich is taking me as his guest to the Stanford Golf Club dinner. I hope you will be there.”
